Our featured speaker last month was Dr. Dianna L. Grayer, MFT, activist, author, playwright, and founder of [Our Lives Matter Theater Company](#). Dr. Grayer spoke of her experiences with racism in Sonoma County and what motivates her to write and produce many plays speaking out about social injustice. While the video didn't turn out well
